A sow is pregnant for 3 months, 3 weeks and 3 days.

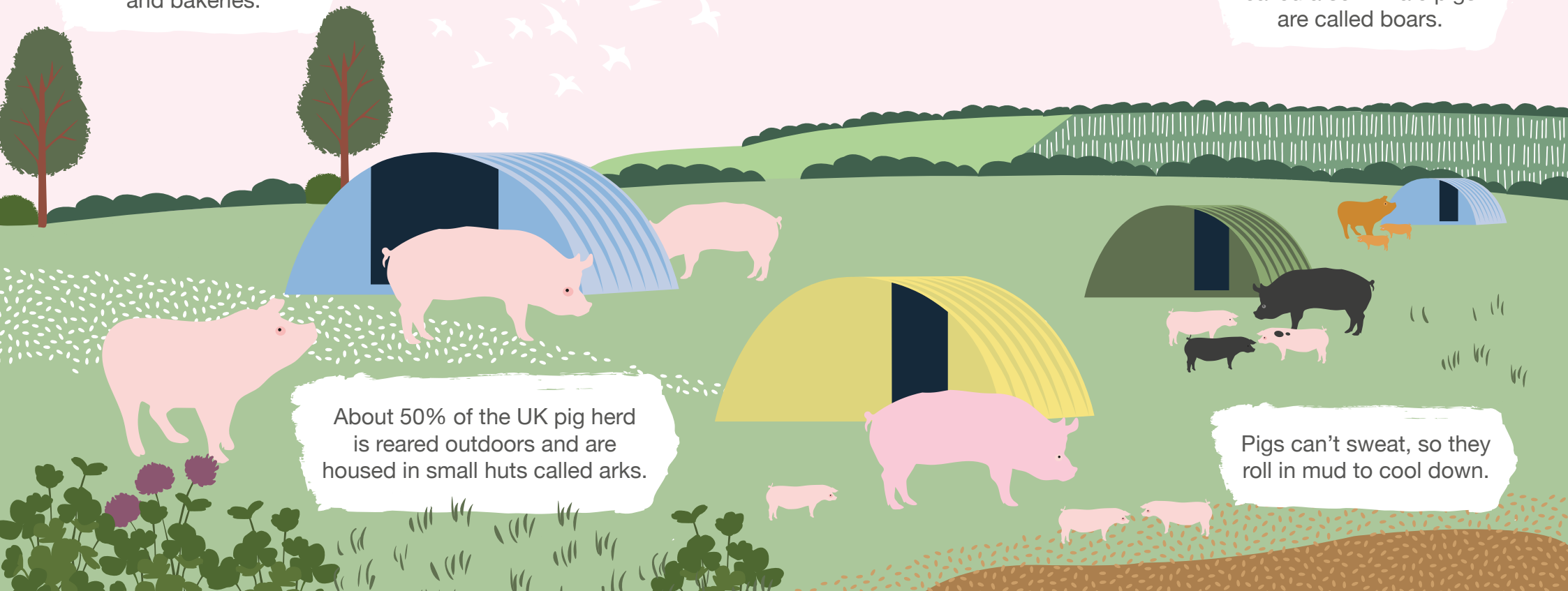
Pig farming - did you know?

Adult pigs eat barley and wheat and are also fed on by-products from dairies, distilleries, and bakeries.

A female pig that has had piglets (baby pigs) is called a sow. Male pigs are called boars.

About 50% of the UK pig herd is reared outdoors and are housed in small huts called arks.

Pigs can't sweat, so they roll in mud to cool down.
