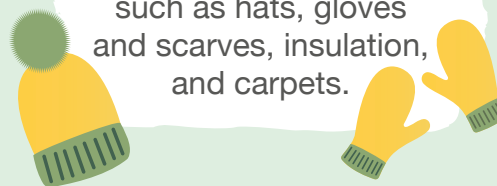


Sheep have 300-degree vision – they can see behind them without having to turn around.

A sheep's wool fleece is removed in the summer to stop them from getting too hot and keep them clean – this is called shearing.

Wool is made into clothes such as hats, gloves and scarves, insulation, and carpets.



A mature female sheep is called a ewe, and mature male sheep is called a ram.

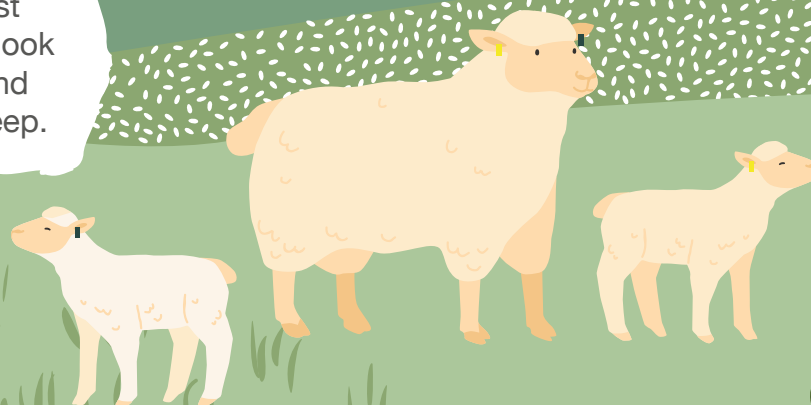
Sheep farming - did you know?

The main lambing period is from March to April, when the grass starts growing.

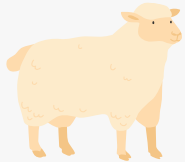
